ELECTION RESULTS

Our Tlingit and Haida Community had an ELECTION FOR DELEGATES, the people chosen to represent you at Central Council General Assembly in Juneau on April 20 – 24 are: Will Micklin, Jackie Clark, Kathy Paddock, Scott Fulton and Laurie Kozisek. This will be an exciting convention because 3 people are running against our current President, Bill Martin, who is one of our own from San Francisco. We wish Bill well. We will also elect 6 new Vice Presidents. Tribal business for the year is reviewed at this convention. We will be reporting items of interest to you when we return.

We ELECTED OUR BOARD OF DIRECTORS for 2 years. They are as follows: Kathy Paddock, President; Loy Arandela, Vice President; Jackie Clark, Treasurer; Will Micklin, Recording Secretary; Laurie Kozisek, Newsletter/Communications Secretary; Scott Fulton and Liza Zaldivar, Members at Large. We have a new Membership Chairperson, Roberta Martorella; Scholarship Chairperson, Margaret Wolley and Loy Arandela serve as our "Emergency Fund Chairperson". The Emergency Fund is for those members who have tried other financial aid avenues and still need emergency assistance. The fund is not large so we have designated it for urgent needs.

Native hosts rotate weekly with Lakota Harden, Janeen Antoine, Morningstar Gali, Ras K'Dee and Gregg McVicar. Gregg is Tlingit, and Lakota and Janeen are adopted Tlingit, so their programs often relate to us. Bay Native Circle is live at 94.1 and podcast can be listened to online everywhere, anytime at kpf.org.
