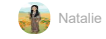

- Set a budget
 Decide how much we want to spend in different categories. This is only an example I did not enter any real numbers or data of into the graph. We will have to set expectations for each category we choose.

Sealaska Covid \$15,000



- We should have an application
 My thoughts on the application is this is mainly to get citizen information and the category in which their need falls in for our budgeting purposes. I do not think we should stay as neutral as possible. We should not be deciding who's need is more important.
- My examples for categories
 - SFTHCC Events
 We will need to set aside money to possibly rent hand washing stations and other PPE items for events down the road.
 - SFTHCC & Sealaska Citizens
 This would be gift cards, essential item bags, prescription medication help, and other service directly related citizen needs. This could also include postage?
 - Community Groups
 This would include Southern Winds, Calaska, Alaska Native Day/Fort Ross, and Native American opencommunity groups.
 - Immediate/Emergency need
 This would be unexpected needs or events we did not account for
 - Savings
 How long do want this money to last?
- I do not want to see us use the funds for services that other community services can cover. We have already voted that we would directing people to services in earlier meetings. For example, if someone needs food, we should research the local food bank for the resident and maybe even find a way to assist with delivery. Maybe a board member, friend, or citizen can be called upon to help
